**Visa:**  
It is highly recommended that, if necessary for your nationality, entry visas to Uganda are acquired prior to departure. Please consult with your operations officers for assistance/advice. UNLP holders do not require entry visas.

For those who are unable to obtain visas pre-departure, arrangements can be made so that participants may obtain visas upon arrival at the airport, for a cost of \$100 USD.

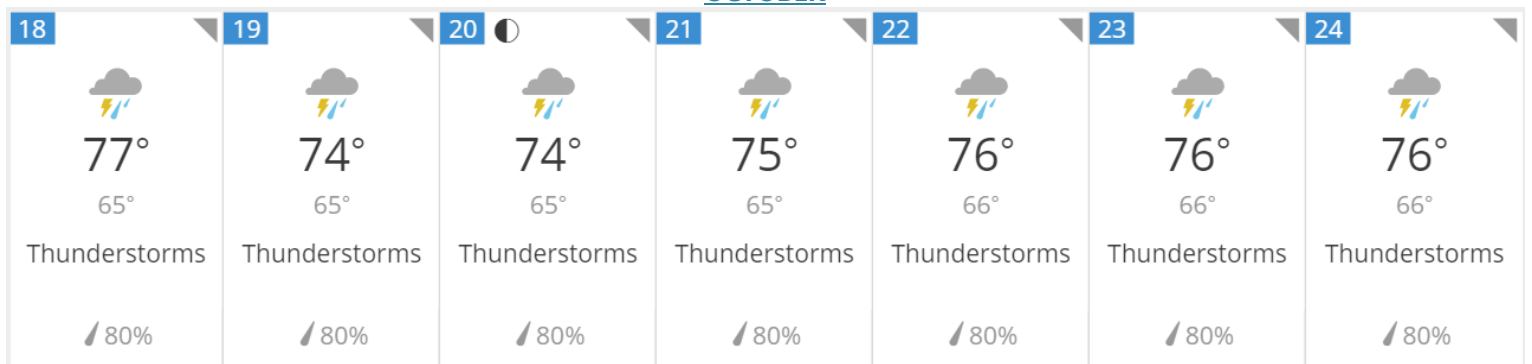

### LOCAL INFORMATION

**ELECTRICITY:** 240V, 50 Hz, on sockets shown on the right

**DRESSING CODE:** We recommend smart casual dressing for this workshop, but beware of air conditioning in the venue.

**CURRENCY:** 1 USD is about 3,680 (UGX), with normal market fluctuations.

**CASH ADVANCE:** From many ATMs, common throughout the city, however may not be available at the meeting venue.



### HEALTH & TRAVEL INSURANCE

All participants are strongly encouraged to buy health travel insurance before travelling. Emergency and hospital claims would **not** be covered by the organizers or the public health system would any emergency occur. Please contact your usual insurance provider or travel agency.

It also is advisable to have a Yellow Fever vaccination card or certificate, as it may be required by the Ugandan health officials upon arrival at Entebbe International Airport (notably from countries where the fever is endemic).
